Flexibility in Determining Child Welfare Formula Factors	Rather than specify in statute certain factors that must be considered when developing the child welfare allocation, allow the Child Welfare Allocation Committee and the state to jointly determine those factors that make the most sense. Enforceable Protection Orders in Dependency & Neglect (D&N) Cases	Authorize judges to grant civil protection orders during a D&N case when in the best interest of the child. This ensures the order is placed in the central registry to be enforced by law enforcement and allows the order to continue on after the D&N case closes. Allocation of Parental Responsibilities in Juvenile Delinquency (JD) Cases	Provide procedure for judges to issue an Allocation of Parental Responsibilities order during a JD case. This helps the court establish permanency for juveniles more quickly and avoids the need to open a separate case.	HB17-1110 (Beckman, Todd)	Governor Signed	Allison Daley
Local Government Partnership in Downtown Development Authorities (DDA)	Similar to the Urban Renewal Authority statutes, require representation for counties, special districts and schools on DDA boards and require all local government partners whose property taxes are used to support blight remediation efforts to enter an intergovernmental agreement specifying how redevelopment costs will be shared among participating entities.	SB17-285 (Grantham, K Becker & Lawrence)	Postponed Indefinitely	Gini Pingenot
Perfecting of Easements for Broadband Infrastructure	Allow counties the ability to perfect easements for existing broadband infrastructure.		Not Introduced	Brandy DeLange/ Eric Bergman
Restore Local Government Authority to Acquire or Construct Broadband Infrastructure	Authorize counties to acquire, construct or finance broadband infrastructure by repealing the statutory prohibitions contained in SB05-152. Modify Local Improvement District Requirements for Telecommunications Infrastructure	Expand the ownership requirements under the Local Improvement District (LID) statute to facilitate local broadband infrastructure development.
