



CCI Legislative Process

3 months long

1. Solicit proposed ideas – through **Friday, June 28th**
 - a. Should have 40-60 legislative ideas that get compiled
2. **Friday, July 19th** 9-noon @ CCI– preview of the ideas that have been submitted
 - a. Counties who submitted ideas present. No voting.
 - b. Peers ask questions and suggest solutions outside of legislation or potential changes to the proposal
3. District meetings – August – September
 - a. Ideas are deliberated over at each District Meeting. No voting.
4. All member meeting – **September 27th** 9-3pm @ CCI– convene by steering committee
 - a. Narrow down the list of submitted ideas
 - i. Some issues are found to have non-legislative changes
 1. Administrative fixes
 2. Creative solutions
 3. Other venues to get issues resolved
 - a. Needing money? JBC
 - b. Discussions with Department Heads
 - c. Other entities (like clerks association) working on the issue
 - d. Interim Committees may be a good vehicle
 - ii. Some issues are combined
 - b. If votes are taken, simple majority is needed to move an idea forward to CCI's October meeting
5. **October 11th** 10-2pm @ CCI – Membership meeting – legislative committee meeting – Organized into steering committees.
 - a. Strive to have representation from every county.
 - b. Goal to get list down to a manageable number
 - i. 8-10 bills
 - c. Super majority (65%) vote of members to approve an issue as a CCI bill

Strongest issues:

1. Are well thought through and vetted through a county attorney – specific legislative changes offered
2. Are pain points for many counties
3. Have already been discussed with legislators
4. Land in the realm of a county commissioners' duty
5. Issues should have the approval of the entire BOCC
