 We are observing an increasing number of deaths on rural highways due to center-line cross over.

 While Colorado State Patrol includes mandatory reporting regarding suspected causes of either

 1) Alcohol/Drugs or 2) Excessive Speed, the report blotter does not include reporting of suspected cause of accident due to distracted driving.

Increasing data gathering due to suspected causes of center-line crossover fatalities will help determine whether more severe penalties for distracted driving should be imposed. Current fines imposed by CRS 42-4-239 limit the fine amount to \$50. This section was
