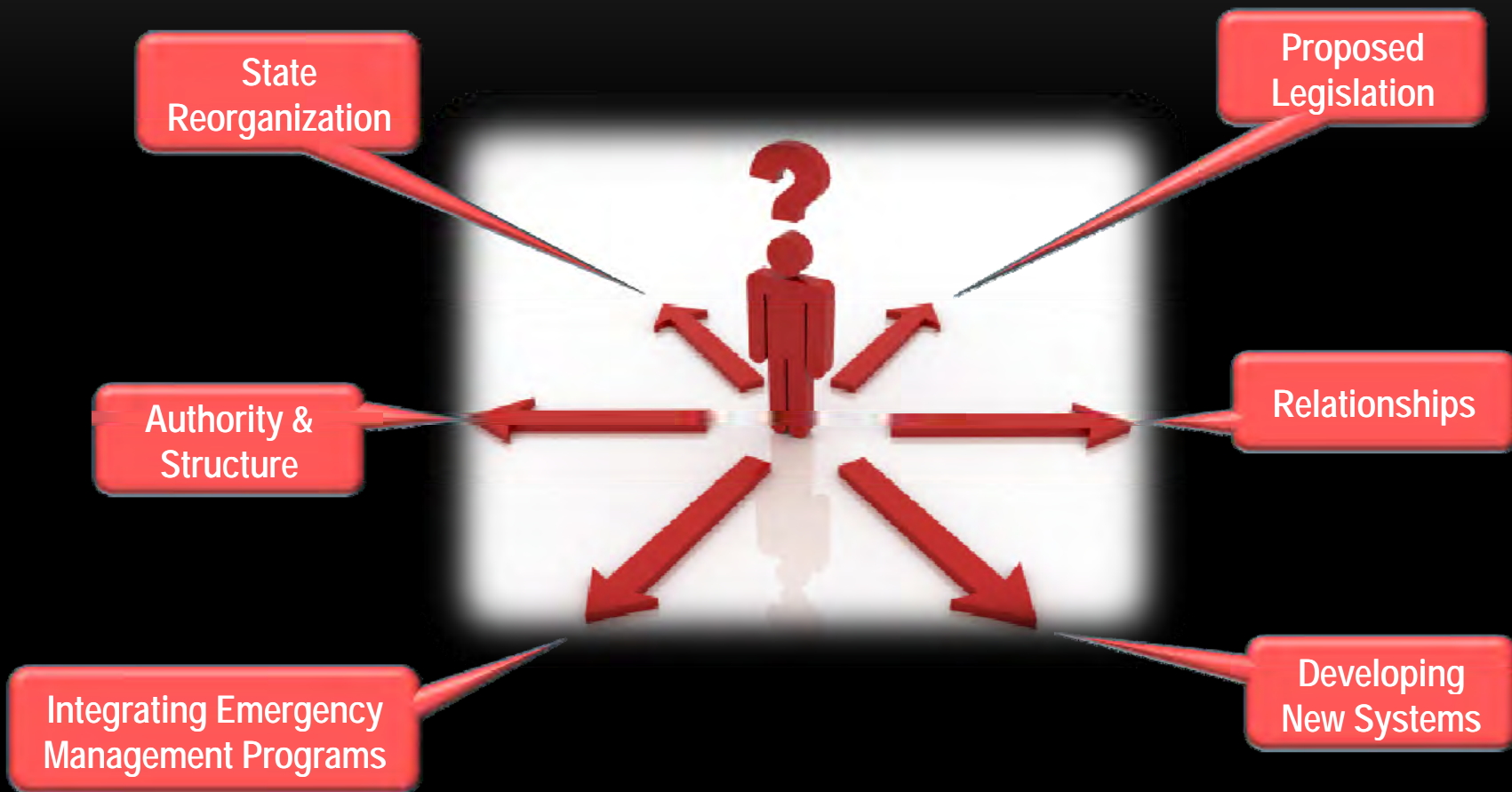


# LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

- When a disaster occurs...
  - And mutual aid is exhausted emergency management should facilitate resource mobilization.
  - Emergency Management supports operational response
  - Emergency Management creates and manages the unmet needs of a disaster.
  - Emergency Management manages recovery or assists with the coordination.
- There are many different styles and ways to structure and deliver emergency management programs.
- Knowing your local emergency management system capability is important.
- All events begin and end locally, may involve state support and almost always require a cost share.
- Coordination locally and in your region is important.

Pandemic Preparedness



- Should we have integrated local emergency management programs and systems?
- Is our local mutual aid and resource mobilization well developed?
- Do we have critical stakeholders engaged?
- What is our local capability? (response, unmet needs, public information & messaging, community engagement and recovery)
- Can we manage 2-4 days on our own using our current systems?
- Is our local system built around accurate recognition of state capabilities?
- What is our capability to provide for unmet needs, hold together our community, and achieve the new normal?



# WHAT IS THE MODEL?

- A consequence management system?
  - Do wait for the event to escalate beyond local capability before we develop the disaster management system?
- Or should it be a predictive, implemented based on probability and create an intervention system?
  - Identify severity triggers as possible, bring together subject matter experts to determine likelihood then execute developing the intervention response to stop the escalation

- Regardless of the type of model it must include partnerships and cooperation to achieve success!
