Extension of Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency in

Elbert County, Colorado

WHEREAS, the County declared a local disaster emergency on 16 March 2020 which was valid for seven days, and

WHEREAS, the current situation in the County, the State, the Nation, and the world continues to be of significant concern to the citizens of Elbert County,

WHEREAS, the conditions of the 16 March 2020 declaration need to be continued for another seven days, from 23 March 2020 through 29 March 2020,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The local disaster emergency status shall be continued for seven days.
- 2. This resolution shall be effective upon the date and time given below, and shall remain in effect for a period not to exceed seven (7) days thereafter except by or with the consent of a majority of the members of the Board. True copies will be filed promptly with the Department of Public Safety, Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management, Office of Emergency Management and the Elbert County Clerk and Recorder, and shall be promptly distributed to the appropriate representatives of the news media.
