

JACKSON COUNTY GOVERNMENT SERVICES DURING COVID-19

In an effort to slow the potential spread of COVID-19 in our community, Jackson County government will be closing public access to buildings **starting on Thursday, March 19, 2020 at 8am**. Staff will be providing limited essential services via phone and online avenues. In-person contact for receiving essential services will have limited restrictions during this time. **These adjustments to county services and public access will be in place until a further notice.**

These precautions will be continually evaluated and may be subject to change. Operation changes include the following Jackson County Government Departments and will be updated as new information related to the COVID-19 situation becomes available.

The follow departments will be closed to the public until further notice:

The Jackson County Swimming Pool is closed to all public access until April 30th per the Colorado Public Health Order 20-22. You can still contact the pool at 970-723-8629.
