Governor Polis Takes Action to Address COVID-19

DENVER - Governor Jared Polis extended Executive Orders in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Governor signed an Executive Order directing the Colorado Department of Human Services to access <u>federal funds for child care services</u>. The Governor also signed <u>Executive Order D 2020 146</u>, extending the ability for Coloradans to continue getting marriage licenses while clerk and recorder offices are closed. He also extended orders suspending <u>certain regulatory statutes</u> due to COVID-19, and concerning <u>petition collection</u> for unaffiliated and independent candidates.
