Governor Polis amended and extended an <u>Executive Order</u> regarding <u>Protect Our Neighbors</u> and the State's response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Governor also signed an <u>Executive Order</u> amending <u>Executive Order B 2019</u> 006, changing the date that the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) is required to report progress made on the implementation of Executive Order B 2019 006 from June 18, 2020, to September 1, 2020. This amendment is necessary due to CDPHE's role in responding to COVID-19 in Colorado.
