In response to the request for documentation in support of Gilpin County's application for "Protect Our Neighbors" status under the July 9, 2020 Executive Order D-2020-127 which application requests permission for critical retail businesses to operate at 50% capacity (with activities not to exceed 500 people in a given location), St. Anthony Hospital will continue to monitor its available ICU beds and ventilators, and it regularly monitors its supply of personal protective equipment and hospital staff in anticipation of and in preparation for a surge or resurgence of COVID-19 patients.
