

# 2024 Session Bills


	Introduced	PI'd/Lost	Passed	% Passed

Construction Bidding Cost Thresholds for Department of Transportation Projects



The bill raises the threshold for a project to be competitively bid to \$300,000 and adds an inflationary adjustment to the cost cap. The bill also requires CDOT to report annually on highway maintenance projects that cost no more than the project cost cap.



Signed by Gov. Polis on April 19, 2024

Local Government Utility Relocation in Right-of-Way.



The bill requires local governments to notify affected utility companies of projects and establishes a process re- relocation of utilities; to coordinate on road improvement projects; and to commit to a schedule for utility relocation.

More Uniform Local Massage Facilities Regulation



Requires counties & municipalities to establish a process by which a massage facility operator, owner, or employee submit to a fingerprint-based criminal history record check, if such businesses operate in the jurisdiction.

Grace Period Noncompliance Digital Accessibility



This bill grants a one-year extension for public agencies to comply with digital accessibility standards, moving the deadline to July 1, 2025. This extension applies to agencies demonstrating good faith efforts towards compliance or resolving any noncompliance complaints, thereby providing temporary immunity from liability

Local Government Property Tax  
Credits Rebates



The bill authorizes BOCC's to establish a property tax credit or rebate program, designed to directly improve an area of specific local concern.

Children's Behavioral Health Statewide System of Care



The bill requires the behavioral health administration (BHA), in partnership with other state and local partners, to develop a comprehensive children's behavioral health statewide system of care -- to serve as the single point of access to address the behavioral health needs of children and youth in Colorado.

Rights-of-Way Permits for Broadband Deployment



The bill creates an alternative method for entities that want to access rights-of-way for the deployment of broadband. The bill allows for the utilization of either the permit application and fee process created in the bill or the existing public-private initiative agreement process.


## WOTUS

- Following the U.S. Supreme Court's ruling in Sackett v. EPA HB24-1379 establishes a state-level program to regulate dredge and fill activities in state waters.
- This bill incorporated longstanding federal guidelines as well as adopted the Army Corps of Engineers existing Nationwide Permits.
- This was a bipartisan effort that will give strong environmental protections while also giving certainty to the regulatory community.

## SB24-233

- Reduction in Property Valuation Rates
- Exemptions for Homeowners
- Reimbursement Mechanism for Local Governments
- Revenue Growth Limit
- Property Tax Deferral Program
