Staff Feedback	Risk/Difficulty: Low – A bill creating an option for flexibility in creating an
	entertainment district could be successful. Local chambers and businesses
	would be likely allies. Sponsors would still need to be secured.
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<u>Time Commitment:</u> Medium – Staff would be responsible for securing
sponsors and conducting stakeholder meetings, as well as seeing the bill
through the process. However, drafting appears to be simple, especially if
an option is created for smaller counties.
