

# Goals, Policies, and Strategies

### **Land Use and Housing:**

- Prioritize infill development, support ADUs, and expand housing options
- Support sustainable and responsible land use planning for growth and development
- Encourage greater density in defined growth areas, particularly in transit areas

### **Built Environment & Connections**


 Support existing communities and accommodate growth and development that coordinates with local plans, is fiscally and environmentally responsible, and enhances the overall well-being of the community.

### **Economic Development:**

• Encourage redevelopment of brownfields and infill parcels

### Agricultural and Natural Resource Preservation:

- Support higher density development to infill areas, along with areas serviced by water and sewer to reduce development pressure on agricultural lands.
- Encourage new development in a manner compatible with the preservation of open space
- Promote development strategies that mitigate impacts to important natural areas
